

The FASEB SRC **Genetic Recombination and Genome Rearrangement** will host a career development workshop on Thursday July 15, 2017, from 1:30 to 2:30 pm before Session 8. We will have speaker representatives from academia as well non-traditional career paths on a panel who will describe their experiences in the field and answer questions from students and postdoctoral fellows. We anticipate that this will be a subset of the young scientists attending the meeting and will have the session in a more intimate setting where attendees can voice their questions to the panel and have a free discussion about career-related issues.

To provide some structure to the discussion before opening the panel to questions from the attendees, we will ask the panelists to discuss the following issues:

- what experiences have you had during your career that you think are important and instructive for current trainees in science?
- how do you personally approach the challenges of work:life balance?
- what advice can you give trainees about surviving in the current funding and political landscape we have?
